

January 5, 2022, VHASS Communications Drill Summary:

The Regional Healthcare Coordination Center (RHCC) conducted a regional emergency communications drill with all healthcare organizations that serve medically vulnerable populations (Long Term Care, Dialysis, Hospice/Home Health, Ambulatory Surgery Centers, ICF/IID, etc.) from 9AM-12PM on Wednesday, January 5, 2022.

At 9AM on January 5, 2022, RHCC created a VHASS Event called “*Regional Communications Drill – January 5,*” and sent a text message alert to all users with an active VHASS alerting profile. Participating organizations had a 3-hour window to participate in the drill. Completion of the communications drill took participants approximately 2 minutes each.

To assist with regulatory and accreditation documentation, organizations who completed the below steps are receiving this written certification of their participation in the emergency communications drill from CVHC.
